#### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION**

**Report from Lincolnshire County Councillor Cawrey** – Cllr Cawrey reported on the progress of the eastern bypass construction; Bracebridge Heath site visit with Highways officers in particular to discuss the damaged barrier on London Road/Canwick Avenue.

A: CIIr Cawrey explained that this was for cyclists and pedestrians and was part of the commitment for more sustainable living.

**Reports from North Kesteven District Councillors Burley, Cawrey & Moran** – Cllr Cawrey reported on the updated cycling strategy; community champion awards held online on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020; Annual Council meeting and discussion of the electoral review, home finder policy, and COVID support grants.

Cllr Burley reported on a new initiative for long-term empty homes; new paper and card recycling bin coming to homes in North Kesteven in autumn 2021; physical meeting availability at NKDC offices in Sleaford by appointment; 2020 electoral canvas; and an initiative to increase trees.

A: CIIr Burley explained that bags can be issued if space is a problem. Residents may refuse the additional bin.

A: Cllr Burley explained that shredded paper was not suitable for the machinery at the recycling plant.
